Catharine Hydon - A Relationship of Possibilities

Listening to the voice of children to build collaborative curriculums.

Learning to listen well is a deep sign of our respect for children's rights and enables us to plan effectively for their learning. Becoming such listeners is a reflective pursuit that can be more complex than first imagined. But there are pathways that will guide us towards a more meaningful engagement with the voices of children - from simple recognition to collaborative action, beyond the pleasantries of chatter to the dialogue of equals.

Using practice examples, our theoretical foundations and the inspiration of key early childhood thinkers this master class will consider how to listen more ethically to children, provide them with more opportunities to speak in their own voices and use this information to plan engaging programs that enrich children's learning.
